

CALL FOR PROPOSALS

Kang Joon-Ho Research Grant

The Korean American Association for Sport Management (KAASM) is pleased to announce the Kang Joon-Ho Research Grant. Professor Joon-Ho Kang at Seoul National University has committed to donate \$1,000/year to advance outstanding scholarship among emerging Korean sport management scholars.

Award

Each year, a total grant pool amount will be \$1,000 per year. One or two outstanding awards will be given in a year. Awards will be announced at the annual KAASM conference in conjunction with NASSM conference.

Eligibility

This award is open to all faculty and post-docs who earned their terminal degree before the grant submission. The PI must be a current professional member and must have been a KAASM member for the previous two consecutive years prior to the application. All co-investigators listed on the application must be a current member of KAASM in good standing at the time of the application.

Deadline

Applicants should indicate their intent to apply in an email to the current Program Director, Dr. Gi-Yong Koo (wkoo@troy.edu) by Friday March 22, 2019. Upon receipt of this email, applicants will submit the final proposal by Friday April 26, 2019. Proposals submitted after this deadline will not be considered.

Submission requirements

- Coversheet detailing project title, applicant name, affiliation, email address, principal investigator (PI), CO-PI, budget requested and justification.
- Abstract of the proposed research (less than 100 words)
- Goals of the project (less than 500 words)
- Plans for conducting the project (less than 500 words)
- Itemized budget justification (Funds shall be used primarily for data collection, access to archives and etc. but shall not be expended for equipment normally provided by the applicants' institutions. Expenses should not pre-date the award).



- CV of principal investigator
- Only one proposal per investigator (whether primary of otherwise) per year is allowed.
- Primary investigators who received this grant are eligible to apply again three years from date that they received the grant.
- Proposals should follow APA guidelines.
- All work must be completed within a year of the date the grant is awarded.

Evaluation Criteria

- Originality of the research in the sport management and neighboring fields (25%)
- Potential contribution to advance theoretical knowledge in the field (25%)
- Clarity on the goals of the project and plans to conduct the project (30%)
- Potential contribution to the advancement of the Korean sport industry and business practice (10%)
- Capability and potential to complete their proposed research in a given time (10%)
- Preference will be given to junior faculty when multiple applications have similar evaluation scores.

Post-Award

Award recipients are expected to adhere to the following guidelines:

- Submit status reports on the progress of the research as requested by the committee.
- Retain their membership within KAASM for at least one (1) year post-award.
- Present a summary of findings at annual KAASM meeting and provide them for KAASM's use in promoting the grant program and its recipients.
- Include the following statement in all written documents including publications and presentation materials, and print and electronic communications that result from successful funding: "This project was supported by funds received from the Kang Joon-Ho KAASM Research Grant Program."
- PIs must assume personal responsibility for the proposal, execution of the research plan, and presentation of the results.

Committee

The Program Director will charge a review committee consisting of three faculty members who have no conflict of interest to ensure transparency in the process.
